Prepare a 10-minute presentation on one of the following topics.

Pay attention to PPT requirements (content, layout, structure, references) and the way you present your ideas.

Concepts: Identities, Experiences, Human Ingenuity, Social Organisation, Sharing the Planet.

Presentation topics:

1) *Identities:*

- How do language and culture contribute to forming our identity?
- How does one's identity fit into a community?

2) *Experiences:*

- To what extent are we shaped by the rites of passage we undergo on a journey from adolescence to adulthood?
- How can a person's creativity contribute to success in life?

3) *Human Ingenuity:*

- How might future scientific and technological innovation change the human species?
- How can developments in science and technology create a better world for us all?

4) *Social Organisation:*

- What opportunities and challenges does the 21st Century bring to education and work?
- In what way and why do you need to be a really effective 21st Century learner?

5) *Sharing the Planet:*

- What are today's biggest environmental challenges to the world and what can be done to help and/or prevent them?
- How does the notion of equality affect your worldview?

English Language and Literature

Concepts: Identity, culture, creativity, communication, representation, transformation and perspective

Presentation topics:

- Talk about a piece of art (book, painting, music) that has changed your perception of the world.
- Think of a social problem and show how people's attitude towards it changed with time. Use literary and/or non-literary texts to support your ideas.

- Choose a literary and a non-literary text (advertisement, painting, film, documentary, essay, biography, etc), and show the different ways how they approach the same problem (cultural, social, political).
- Choose a literary genre and show how it has changed with time.
- Choose one IB learner profile characteristics and present its importance through a short story/novel/essay/biography.
